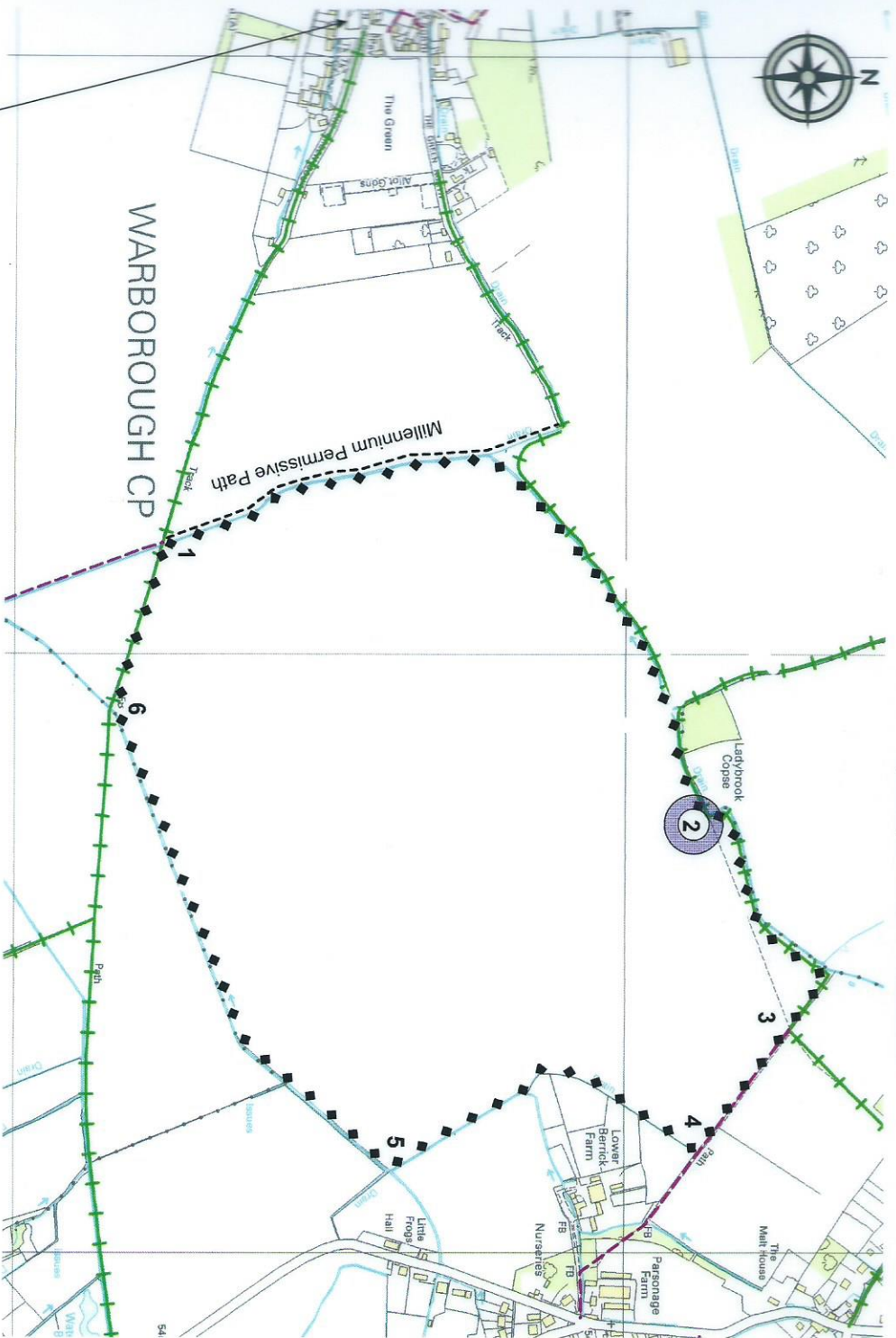


Warborough Jubilee Permissive Path

Distance of circular route - approx. 2 1/2 miles

Walk directions

- 1 The path heads North on East bank of deep drainage ditch, then turns east to follow hedge-row and ditch. *This field was once known as Costall Lease.*
2. The Jubilee path now joins the bridleway to continue east. To shortcut back to Warborough cross over the bridge (west). *There was a major earthwork near here called Round Ridge Waye. A Roman settlement was found as well as Bronze Age burials.*
3. Take footpath west of hedge, to junction with ditch at 4.
4. Walk South West along Northern side of ditch.
- 5 The Jubilee Path continues on the north of ditch and hedge. *A small bridge crossing the stream leads to Roke Village Hall.*
- 6 The Jubilee Path now re-joins the bridleway

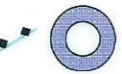
Winter: Chances of seeing Fieldfare & Redwing
